They discovered there was quite a lot to learn if you want to do it right. Phil knows it all and even produced a couple of sections of a model boat he had cut through to show the group what it's made of - needless to say, most don't plan to cut their boats in half to check.



It was then time to sail. Seven boats hit the water from the SASC pontoons. Unfortunately, the wind was elsewhere, but all had a great time.
