We are delighted to launch the inaugural Art@The Rowers acquisitive art exhibition which we plan as a regular annual or biennial event. It was to be held this year as part of the Festival of Mosman but will run in the new year, and it will be wonderful.

The Exhibition and competition is open to artists of all ages and genres - oil, acrylic, pastels and watercolourists, sketchers, printmakers and photographers are invited to submit works inspired by our beautiful Mosman Bay. There are awards for different categories, including local primary school children, local high school and an Open section.

The exhibition, is being supported by the highly accomplished and much loved Australian artist and Mosman local, Ken Done. Mosman Rowers Club Building Fund

As noted in our last newsletter, over the last 3 years we have undertaken significant refurbishment of our sub structure and the Clubhouse, but we still urgently need to increase accessibility, to complete substructure works as part of our lease conditions and to preserve the heritage of the building. The estimated cost of all the works is ~\$500,000-\$700,000.

We now have the Mosman Rowers Club Building Fund in conjunction with the Australian Sports Foundation, enabling us to receive tax deductible donations. The fund is solely for ongoing capital projects and heritage preservation of the Clubhouse.

While the end of final year is now past taxdeductible donations of \$2 or more are appreciated at any time.
