# President's Message

To all our wonderful Mosman Rowers Members,

Firstly to offer our heartfelt condolences to Richard Flook and family on the very sad loss of Professor Emeritus Mary–Louise McLaws, AO. Professor McLaws was a talented expert in her field of epidemiology. Working for the University of NSW she also had numerous other important roles, including serving on international expert panels with the World Health Organisation, and as an adviser to the NSW and Commonwealth governments on the COVID Infection Prevention and Control Taskforce. Professor McLaws was an almost daily voice of calm and reassurance on the radio, providing the latest and most reliable advice and interpretation of news of the pandemic both within Australia and around the world.

She advocated strongly and fearlessly for many of the measures that proved invaluable in the fight against the disease. Not least was the imperative of wearing masks and the routine use of rapid antigen tests, imploring the federal government to make them freely available for routine mandatory use as people returned to work and daily life. A Mosman local, Professor McLaws presented a special In Conversation@The Rowers, providing an easy to understand outline of the crisis and the way out of it, and answered endless questions for our Members. We greatly appreciated her gracious manner, taking the time from her very busy schedule to help reassure the local community.

Vale Mary-Louise, we will remember you very fondly as our softly spoken, very caring friend. We are indebted to you for your important contribution to every Australian.

On a more positive note, we are really pleased that our wonderful series, Exhibitions@The Rowers has done so well, supporting local artists and the Club. Our first was the wonderful Press Gang, a diverse group of Printmakers and Photographers which was very well received. Then the Mosman Art Society's annual exhibition, followed by talented photographer Olga Nebot, with her exhibition Contrast: A Visual Journey; popular local painter, Keith Betts, with his exhibition exploring the landscapes of Sydney waterways; The Manly Art Precinct Group, showcasing a variety of artworks from still life and interiors to landscape and figurative paintings.
